

# FUNDRAISING FOR RSPCA WA DONATION CONTAINER

Donation containers are an important part of our fundraising and a rewarding way for your business to support our cause.

Thanks to your support, the funds that will be raised will help RSPCA WA provide care and new homes for lost, abandoned, injured or abused animals; investigate reports of animal cruelty; educate the community about responsible pet ownership and compassion for animals as well as campaigning on a range of issues such as puppy farming or illicit breeding, battery hens, sow stalls and live export.

To organise a donation container, please read the frequently asked questions below and complete and return the application form on the last page.

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### How often will the RSPCA donation container be emptied?

Paws or wombats are emptied and maintained by volunteers from the Activ Foundation as often as you need. To organise for your container to be emptied, please contact us and we will arrange for a volunteer from the Activ Foundation to visit.

### Will volunteers be identifiable?

Yes RSPCA WA volunteers will have an official ID badge which will be presented or worn when they are collecting. If you are suspicious then ask to see their identification. If you are not confident they are an official RSPCA WA volunteer, please do not proceed and give us a call.

### What happens after my donation container is collected?

Our volunteer will return the funds to RSPCA WA where they will be counted. It would be helpful to have your email address so we can advise the amount raised. Annually we will advise the total amount you have assisted in raising and acknowledge your support with a certificate.



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## What happens if the container is stolen?

RSPCA WA do not hold the business or individual responsible if the donation container is stolen. Each container has a strong string to secure with either a cable tie or padlock. We suggest it is best to secure as they can be an easy target. We **do not** suggest taking chase in the event of it being stolen, instead please notify RSPCA WA and notify the police.

RSPCA WA will arrange a replacement.

## What if my circumstances change and I no longer want a donation container?

If at any time you want to return or arrange for your donation container to be collected, please contact us and a volunteer will collect at their earliest convenience.

- Please ensure the donation container is secured using the attached chain or rope.
- Empty the donation container regularly to reduce the risk of losing the funds donated.
